Warringtons Womens Aid have been chosen as the NWCC Charity for 2020

Warrington Women's Aid was founded in 1976 by a group of local women who were concerned about domestic abuse, its impact on women and children and where they could go if they had to leave home due to violence.

The group, known as Warrington and District Battered Wives Association began by negotiating with Warrington Council for the allocation of a council property where families could be housed and supported

Warrington Housing Department was unable to offer such a property due to local policy at the time

During this time the group became Warrington Women's Aid and a

registered charity

After two years of fundraising they purchased and renovated a property in Warrington, which became the first refuge/hostel for battered wives, opening in 1978, it could house three women and up to four children
